SCHOOL STATUS PARENT NOTIFICATION

Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s):

In December 2015, the *Every Student Succeeds Act* (ESSA), the replacement for the *Elementary and Secondary Education Act* (commonly known as *No Child Left Behind*) was signed into law. In an effort to ensure parents of students who attend Title I schools are notified on how well their school is preparing students for college and/or a career, our district mandates all schools inform parents of their College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI score). The comprehensive report card for all schools in Georgia, provides a score between 0 - 100 for each school-measuring how well the school is doing in preparing students to be successful in college and/or a career.

Kendrick Middle School earned a CCRPI score of 71.2 for the 2016-2017 school year. For additional detail information on how this score was obtain please visit the following website <http://ccrpi.gadoe.org>

Our 2017 GMAS Data revealed the following:

Our Economically Disadvantaged student's make-up over 90% of our population. However, our 2017 GMAS Results revealed that only 17% are proficient in the area of English Language Arts; 14% proficiency in the areas of Mathematics, 6% in Science, and 25% proficient in the area of Social Studies. Students from a variety of racial and ethnics groups, also known as our Multi-racial students, make up 1% of our school's population. The 2017 GMAS Results revealed that 33% scored proficient in the area of English Language Arts, 40% proficiency in the area of Mathematics; 50% proficiency in the area of Social Studies and 33% proficiency in the area of Science. Our English Language Learners make up 4% of our population. The GMAS Results revealed that 3% demonstrated proficiency in the area of English Language Arts, 8% in the area of Mathematics, none of our ELL students demonstrated proficiency in the areas of Science and Social Studies. Finally, our Students with Disabilities make up 14% of our school's population. Three percent of our Students with Disabilities demonstrated proficiency in the area of English Language Arts, 5% in Mathematics; 6% demonstrated proficiency in Social Studies and 6% in the area of Science.


After reviewing our school-wide data, we discovered that Kendrick Middle School has many strengths. The strengths include that on average our students maintain a 95% attendance rate. Our discipline rate has shown a declined over the last 3 years. Although we have only administered the GMAS for three consecutive years, there is evidence that our students are making progress. We increased the number of students scoring in the proficient category in the areas of Language Arts, Science, Math, and Social Studies in all grade levels. The data also disclosed an increase in the number of students from Beginning Learner to Developing Learner, which again demonstrates a move in the right direction.

At Kendrick Middle School we take pride in the instruction we provide for our children. Our teachers and staff members work very hard to meet the needs of all students to ensure they achieve at their highest potential.

An important part of Kendrick Middle School's success is parent participation and support in developing activities to improve student achievement. We hope that you will become engaged in our school improvement work as we continue to monitor student achievement and set high expectations.
